**Approval procedure for construction and operation of the “Nord Stream”
high-pressure natural gas pipeline through the Baltic
Scoping document for the Nord Stream Gas pipeline from the boundary of
the German EEZ up to the landing point close to the Lubmin
power-generating plant site**

Dear Sirs,

No objections in principle exist to the proposed scope of examination, including delineation of areas of examination and assessment, to the scope of examination, with proposed structure for the EIS, including the proposed contents, assessment and evaluation criteria and assessment methods and scope for surveys in the context of this project as far as any potential effect on our interests are concerned.

It is important from the point of view of our interests that the EIS should determine clearly what harmful effects from installation of this pipeline may be anticipated at what times of the year for the entire aquatic flora and fauna. In addition, the potentials for compensatory provisions, in particular for coastal fishing in the vicinity of the boundary of the EEZ and extending up to the landing point at the Lubmin power-generating plant in the *Greifswalder Bodden* ("Greifswald Lagoon"), must also be stated.

We are, for reasons of existing appointments, unable to attend the hearing to be held in the Intercity Hotel in Stralsund on January 30, 2007. We kindly request you, if possible, to forward information concerning the result of the vote to us.
